The meeting was convened at 6 PM.

President Bill Brown welcome the participants and offered congratulations to Mayor Dean Trantalis and Vice Mayor Steve Glassman on their re-election.

Vice Mayor Glassman delivered the following updates:

- The city is reviewing the permit for the adult toy store on Almond Avenue. Almond Avenue was removed from CRA projects in the anticipation of developers upgrading the area.
- Asked that everyone follow safety precautions and initiatives during the Air Show.
- The City has engaged a company to test our waterways in ten locations.
- City intends to monitor the parking at the temporary fire station as a potential for a future garage.

Emily Asp and Ashley Wilson presented on the **Sea Turtle Grant Lighting Program**. Up to \$215,000 in funds to retrofit lighting on the beach is available from August 1, 2020 to July 21, 2022.

Karlanne Grant, Urban Planner with the City of Fort Lauderdale, presented the **Central Beach Code Updates**.

Courtney Crush presented a development plan for **527-533 Bayshore Drive**. The plans will require approval for height and outdoor dining.

Dr. Elizabeth King presented the **John and Elizabeth's Toy Drive** and requested CBA help in raising funds to distribute toys. Over 55,000 toys have been distributed over the years.
